I very much appreciated the opportunity to discuss matters of interest with you yesterday.

In the light of the observations made by both Michael Jordan and myself on the interrelationship between boards of directors and auditors, coupled with the current concerns about the effectiveness of audit, we have put together a short paper in support of the view that the public interest would be served by a speedy but comprehensive review of the broad issue of corporate governance and accountability.
